WELCOME AND GREETING

Call to Worship and Invocation: (Psalm 95:1-7 ESV)

M: O come, let us sing to the Lord;

C: Let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

M: Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving

C: Let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!

M: For the Lord is a great God,

C: And a great king above all Gods.

M: In his hand are the depths of the earth;

C: The heights of the mountains are his also.

M: The sea is his, for he made it,

C: And his hands formed the dry land.

M: Oh come, let us worship and bow down;

C: Let us kneel before the Lord, our maker!

M: For he is our God,

C: And we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

M: Glory and praise be to you o god, father, son and holy spirit.

C: Amen.

DEVOTIONAL THOUGHT

WORDS OF WELCOME AND THANKSGIVING

(This would be a time for family and friends and the service member to share some thoughts)

TIME OF REFLECTION AND PRAYER

(based on Psalm 91)

M: Whoever goes to the Most High for safety, whoever remains under the protection of the Almighty, can say to the Lord,

C: You are my defender and protector! You are my God; in you I trust.

M: He will surely keep you safe from all hidden dangers, and from all deadly diseases.

C: He will cover you with his wings; you will be safe under his care; his faithfulness will protect and defend you.

M: You will not be afraid of dangers at night, or of sudden attacks during the day, of the plagues that strike in the dark, or of the evils that kill in daylight.

C: A thousand may fall beside you, ten thousand all around you, but you will not be harmed.

M: Because you made the Lord your defender, the Most High your protector, no disaster will strike you, no violence will come near your home.

C: God will put his angels in charge of you to protect you wherever you go.

M: God says, "I will save those who love me, and protect those who know me.

C: When they call to me, I will answer them; when they are in trouble, I will be with them. I will rescue them and honor them, I will surely save them."

M: (Here special petitions may be included, followed by the Lord's Prayer)

C: Amen.
