


REACHING OUT

- A Christian pen pal program
- Religious tracts
- Answers to their questions

- "Facing Freedom"—preparing inmates for life after release from incarceration

ONGOING MINISTRY

Although God has richly blessed our ministry by mail, we are committed to expanding the amount of face-to-face ministry to inmates that we carry out in the name of Jesus who said,

"I was in prison and you visited me." (Matthew 25)

For that reason, we host workshops training volunteers to conduct local jail and prison ministries and offer training to further enhance and sustain existing WELS jail and prison ministries. We have developed training for mentors of released inmates. We help congregations recruit men and women for this work and provide resources for Christ-centered gospel ministry.

The Bible study correspondence courses which we publish for inmates have been recognized for their witnessing and spiritual growth potential. Multi-Language Publications translates them into different languages and reprints them as evangelism and teaching tools.

We continue to write and publish more courses to meet the demand that word of mouth among inmates has created.
