General information – Every booklet shares the same basic format. The lesson, chapter review questions, a section entitled *Review! Plan! Pray! Go Forward!*, and a final test. The *Review! Plan! Pray! Go Forward!* section is meant to help the reader apply the lesson to their current situation and into the future.

## Level Two Correspondence Course Descriptions

**A** Believe and Live – A study of the Gospel of John. *Believe and Live* provides an outlined study of the Gospel written by Apostle John. Also included in the book are chapter tests and maps.

**B** Chosen by Grace – An introduction to Apostle Paul's epistle to the Ephesians. This book outlines God's plan of salvation for both Jews and Gentiles and his gift of saving grace.

**C** Freedom in Christ – A study of the letter to the Galatians. This book reviews Paul's explanation of justification and sanctification to the church in Galatia.

**D** I Am Blessed – An expanded study of the benefits of God's Word. Each of the six chapters focuses on a different area of life that is blessed by the study of Scripture.

**E** No More Fear – A lesson on demons and evil spirits. *No More Fear* is written in a narrative style. The book presents the reality of evil spirits and Jesus' power over them.

**F** Righteous Through Faith – A study of Paul's epistle to the Romans. Outlined chapters include: All people are sinners, New life in Christ, and What God expects of believers.

**G** The Christian Church – An introduction to the history and growth of the Christian Church. Topics include: The early Christian Church, the Reformation, The Teachings of the Lutheran Church, and the Christian Church today.

**H** The Gospel of John – A detailed look at Jesus' ministry using John's Gospel. The reader is led through their Bible and the Gospel of John to learn who Jesus is, prophesies fulfilled, and the blessings received through Jesus.

I The Letter to the Romans – An expanded study of Romans. This book is a brief commentary on Paul's letter. The reader is encouraged to follow along in their Bible as they are led through each chapter.

J The Means of Grace – A study of God's means of grace. This book defines the term means of grace, and reviews how it pertains to Scripture, baptism, and the Lord's Supper.

**K** The Parables of Jesus – An introduction to one of Jesus' favorite teaching styles. This booklet also reviews 15 parables through its six chapters.

**L** The Road to Emmaus – Based on the WELS movie *The Road to Emmaus*. This book reviews Christian doctrine through a study of the last days of Jesus before He ascended into Heaven. Chapter titles include: Jesus' Miracles and Teachings, Law and Gospel, The Passover Lamb and Jesus, and Sharing Jesus with others.

**M** The Lord Cares for Me – A study on the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm. This book uses a narrative style to share the comforting message written by King David.

**N Come Follow Me** – Based on the WELS movie *Come Follow Me*. This book covers the ministry of Jesus. *Come Follow Me* can be used with or without the movie for a study resource.
